Telephone Installation Service

The following policy describes what is included and required in a standard telephone installation. Our installers make every effort to perform the most discreet, professional, and efficient installation possible. Any questions about this policy should be discussed with the installer prior to installation.

Installation Practices

- Telephone service originates from the Network Interface Device which will be provided by RTC and placed on the side of the home where other utilities enter if possible.
- For telephone service subscriber is expected to provide a standard copper conductor communication cable to the NID for connection to the homes telephone jacks. If this is not present and/or the home's interior is not wired for telephone service, it can be installed along with interior jacks and wiring at our standard installation service rates.
- Installer will verify telephone service to the NID at time of installation using a test set and connect all inside wires provided to NID.

Installer has final judgment on installation practices and may decide to use different methods when deemed to be more appropriate for the situation.
